**FINALE LEVEL 2 – INTERMEDIATE SESSION:**  
Learn new features and shortcuts that will help you work more efficiently and increase your productivity. Topics include: Review of Simple and Hyperscribe Entry, Repitch Tool, scanning, plug-ins and metatools, lead sheet, staff styles, page layout tips, percussion notation, layers, recording/importing audio, importing/exporting graphics, MIDI files, custom worksheets and creating Smart-Music practice/assessment files. Basic knowledge of Finale or PrintMusic is required. Please bring a simple project in your area of interest to work on.
- OPTIONAL GRADUATE CREDIT AVAILABLE: One semester graduate credit is available for each session through Hamline University. Both sessions may be taken sequentially for a total of 2 semester credits. College credit requires a separate and additional payment of \$128 per credit to Hamline and is due on the first day of class.
